### **Pacer Racers**

Pacer racing on a short course in front of the clubhouse.

The number of races per day will be decided on the day to suit the number of sailors wishing to participate.

No prizes are given. This is just for fun. Ideal introduction to fun racing for graduates of sailing courses.

### **Fire Bug Fury and Laser Elimination**

Short course elimination series run in front of the clubhouse. Another fun event.

### **Dolphin Trophy**

All boats shall sail the same course. The Dolphin Trophy results shall be based on (HHB&SC) VYC.

### **Consistency Series Overall Results**

One (1) race is required to constitute a series.

When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When four (4) to eleven (11) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her **worst** score.

When twelve (12) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her **two worst** scores.

### **Club Championship Overall Results**

One (1) race is required to constitute a series.

When fewer than four (4) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her **worst** score.

### **Consistency & Club Championship Scoring System**

The HHB&SC Low Point scoring system will be used for both series.

1<sup>st</sup> = 0.75, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 3, 4<sup>th</sup> = 4 and so on. This changes RRS Appendix A - 4.1A.

In the event of a series tie RRS Appendix A – A8 shall apply.

A boat that came to the start area but did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finish place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the series.
