The licensee named above is authorised to sell liquor at the licensed premises described above, in accordance with the Liquor Licensing Act 1988 ("the Act"). The licensee must comply with all requirements and conditions imposed by the Act, any conditions or authorisations published by notice under section 31 of the Act, and any conditions or requirements set out below. The licence continues in force until surrendered, suspended or cancelled under the Act.

1. EXTENDED TRADING PERMITS

The following extended trading permits have been granted under section 60 of the Act. The authorisation to trade pursuant to the licence is modified accordingly.

2. FURTHER CONDITIONS

The following conditions and/or requirements apply to the licence. Where there is any inconsistency between these and other conditions, these conditions/requirements prevail:-

TRADING HOURS - CLUB LICENCE

Unless otherwise varied by a condition on this licence, the permitted trading hours in accordance with section 98E of the Act (excluding Good Friday, Christmas Day or ANZAC Day) are as follows -

- (a) on a day other than a Sunday -
 - (i) from 6 a.m. to 12 midnight; and
 - (ii) then continuing, if the following day is other than a Sunday or New Year's Day, to 12.30 a.m., but only for liquor sold ancillary to a meal supplied by or on behalf of the licensee;
- (b) on a Sunday that is not New Year's Eve -
 - (i) from immediately after 12 midnight on the previous day to 1 a.m.; and
 - (ii) from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m.;
- (c) on a Sunday that is New Year's Eve -
 - (i) from immediately after 12 midnight on the previous day to 1 a.m.; and
 - (ii) from 10 a.m. to 12 midnight;
- (d) on New Year's Day - from immediately after 12 midnight on the previous day to 2 a.m.

2. In this condition "licensed premises" includes any premises, place or area:-

- (a) which is appurtenant to the licensed premises, or
- (b) in respect of which an extended trading permit granted to the licensee is for the time being in force, but does not include any part of the premises which is reserved for the private use of the licensee, manager or employees of the licensee and to which the public does not have access.

TRADING HOURS - CLUB LICENCE

The trading hours are those approved as permitted hours under section 97 of the Act.
No trading is permitted on Good Friday or before noon on Anzac Day.

TRADING CONDITIONS - CLUB LICENCE

The licensee is permitted to sell and supply liquor in accordance with the provisions of section 48 of the Act as it relates to club licences.
The sale of packaged liquor for consumption off the licensed premises is permitted to members only.

GUESTS

The maximum number of guests per member per day for the purposes of section 48(4) of the Act is three.

HARM MINIMISATION

The licensee is required to submit, on or before 7 June 2006, a declaration confirming that a House Management Policy, a Code of Conduct and a Management Plan have been developed by the licensee in respect of these premises.

The House Management Policy and the Code of Conduct must be displayed in a prominent position on the licensed premises.

All three documents must also be retained on the premises and produced to any Authorised Officer if required.

This licence takes effect from **7 March 2006**.
